

School Uniform

We encourage the children to wear school uniform to give a sense of belonging and to raise community awareness. It is intended to be smart, distinctive and versatile. The royal blue sweatshirt with logo and the royal blue polo shirt with logo can be purchased through the school office. The school also holds a supply of second hand uniform that can be bought at a very reasonable price.

WINTER

Girls

Royal blue or white polo shirt
Grey skirt or grey trousers
Plain white socks or grey tights
Royal blue sweatshirt/sweatshirt cardigan
Black shoes (not trainers)

Boys

Royal blue or white polo shirt
Grey trousers
Plain grey socks
Royal blue sweatshirt
Black shoes (not trainers)

SUMMER

Girls

Royal blue and white dress in check or stripes
Royal blue polo shirt and grey skirt
Plain white socks
Black shoes (not trainers or open toed sandals)

Boys

Royal blue or white polo shirt
Grey trousers or grey shorts
Plain grey socks
Black shoes (not trainers or open toed sandals)

P.E. KIT (Boys and Girls)

White T shirt
Royal blue or white shorts
White/Grey socks
Plimsolls and trainers
Small P.E. bag to hang on peg (not sports bag)

Years 4, 5 and 6 will need a swimming costume and towel

In addition, children in key stage 2 will need football socks, shin pads and possibly football boots. It is advisable to provide a tracksuit for wearing during outdoor school games in cold weather.

The school uniform supplier will also supply royal blue PE shorts, royal blue fleeces with the school logo, book bags, rucksacks, royal blue joggers, hats with school logo and royal blue cagoules. None of these are essential school uniform, but are meant to enable parents to easily purchase quality clothing at a reasonable price.
