Can you make your soup?</p> 	<p>Can you design and make a board game? It must contain at least one mountain and a river. Write out the instructions on how to play clearly.</p> 
<p>Can you research another country? What geographical features does it have? What language do they speak there? What does its flag look like? What food do they eat? What is it famous for? What is its capital city? What famous buildings can be found there? Can you compare it to a different country on another continent?</p> 	<p>Design your own land. What is it called? What would it be like? Who would live there? What geographical features would it have? Write a story about your new country. Remember to include a setting and character description.</p> 	<p>Can you design and make your own flag for your new land? What would each feature represent?</p> 	<p>Can you create a national anthem for your imaginary land? Perhaps you can write the music for it too? What words would it have?
